Festival in the Park Application Submission Criteria

APPLICANT MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- High School seniors whose parent's permanent residence is within a 100-mile radius of Roanoke
- Applicant must have been accepted or expect acceptance into a post-secondary educational arts' program for the 2016 fall semester as a full-time student.
- Applicant is planning further study with a MINOR or MAJOR in the fine arts. Music, Dance, Theater, Sculpture, Painting, Photography, Drawing or Computer Graphic design.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: **Application deadline is June 15, 2019.** Prior winners of Festival Scholarships are not eligible. The application must be accompanied by the following:

- 1) A maximum of two (2) recommendations, one of which must be from a teacher, instructor or other professional in the arts. The recommendation should include at least the following information:
 - a) What is the student's potential for future creative expression?
 - b) What is the student's level of performance up to this point in their career?
 - c) Does the student work at "expected" level or work beyond requested level?
 - d) Does student complete work in a timely fashion? If not, why?
 - e) Your perception of the student's artistic ability
- 2) Student should submit examples of their work in the area of interest/ability. These may include DVD, video or cassette recordings, list of stage performances, slides or actual drawings/paintings. Limit submissions to ten (10) pieces of work or slides. Each piece of work must be labeled with the applicant's name (including each slide). Videotapes should include five (5) minutes of recent work and be recorded on clean high-quality tape. Video and audio tapes should be queued to the specific part you wish the judges to view or hear. In a crowded scene, please identify yourself. All slides should be marked as to direction and accompanied by a sheet that lists the size and title of the work. All artwork should be dated and identified and noted if it was a class project, etc. All work submitted should be the original or a slide – no computer printouts. Computer generated or enhanced work will not be reviewed. Standard DVDs can be used to showcase paintings and other art pieces. All work submitted digitally must be on DVD formats that can play on a TV set through a standard DVD player. No eps or Power Point formats will be accepted.
- 3) Musicians submitting original compositions must submit both the written score and a recording of the music, stating who is performing the piece. The composer does not have to be performing the music unless he/she wants to be judged as both performer and composer.
- 4) Past applicants to this scholarship who have not won in any category may submit a new application. Works previously judged for this scholarship may not be included in the new application.
- 5) Proof of full time acceptance into a college, institute or apprenticeship program in the arts must be presented prior to award presentation.
- 6) High School transcripts are NOT necessary and will not be taken into consideration.

Notification to scholarship recipients will be made by June 15, 2019 via letter, e-mail or phone. Payment of awards will be made directly to the college, institute or apprenticeship program after satisfactory proof of acceptance. Scholarship awards may be used to defray expenses of tuition, housing, supplies, etc.
